As indicated in Delaware Riverkeeper Network's comment letter pertaining to the Tohickon Creek Draft DEP report submitted July 11, 2019, enclosed is a CD with larger files that contain various research, reports, and information that we cited in Delaware Riverkeeper Network's comment to include as a Tohickon supplement to the petition package. Though documents for this petition span almost 25 years, we believe some of the reports we share here may be new to the record while others were provided in the past by Tincum Conservancy. In some instances, older hard copy reports were scanned. In any case, we wanted to share related reports we believe will help regarding next steps in the Lake Nockamixon discharge and other evidence supporting softer qualifiers for Exceptional Value status that we referenced and researched for DRN's comment.
