ORDER

NOW, April 4, 2012, upon consideration of petitioners' "application for special and summary relief pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 1532 and/or petition for expedited hearing on motion for preliminary injunction", the application is granted to the extent that it seeks an expedited hearing. Hearing on petitioners' motion for preliminary injunction is set for April 11, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., in Courtroom 3001, Pennsylvania Judicial Center, 601 Commonwealth Ave., Harrisburg, Pa. 17120.

To the extent that petitioners' application for special relief can be construed to request summary relief as to Count XIII of the petition for review, and it appearing that Count XIII seeks the same preliminary injunctive relief as petitioners' motion for preliminary injunction, the application for summary relief is dismissed as duplicative.

Further, it appearing that the judge to whom this case is assigned has issued a real estate interest disclosure, attached hereto as Exhibit A, the Chief Clerk shall send a copy of the judge's disclosure statement at the same time he sends a copy of this order to counsel of record. Any party objecting to the judge presiding over this matter in light of this disclosure shall file a written objection with the Court's Harrisburg filing office no later than Monday, April 9, 2012, at 12:00 p.m.

Respondents shall file an answer to the motion for preliminary injunction in the Court's Harrisburg filing office no later than Tuesday, April 10, 2012, at 12:00 p.m.
